The Federal Electricity Commission confirms the tender for combined cycle plants.

On September 10, 2020, Miguel Santiago Reyes Hernández, General Director of CFEnergía, a subsidiary of the Federal Electricity Commission ("CFE") confirmed, during the sixth edition of the Mexico Gas Summit, that CFE is going to tender 5 combined cycle power plants. The call for said tender will be published in the next 2 or 3 months. These power plants will be in the following locations:

- » Mexicali, Baja California;
- » La Paz;
- » Mérida, Yucatán;
- » Riviera Maya; and
- » Tuxpan.

Miguel Reyes also confirmed that CFE will establish a trust to finance the projects to be tendered. So far, CFE has not released more official information regarding the tender, but we will monitor the publication of the corresponding call to inform our clients, in a timely manner, of new details.
